Discipline is the on-going process of helping children to develop their controls so that they can manage their own behavior in socially approved/acceptable ways.

## HOW DISCIPLINE WILL BE IMPLEMENTED BY STAFF

Appropriate discipline techniques used include:

- \* Avoid problems by offering an organized, stimulating program.
- \* Reinforcement for positive behavior.
- \* Modeling.
- \* Redirection to a more acceptable behavior.
- \* Setting clear limits.
- \* Offering choices.
- \* Ignoring negative behavior (when appropriate).
- \* Acknowledging good behavior.
- \* Time-out or removal of the child from the area, for short periods of time. (One minute per age of child). \*For children over age two and older only.
- \* Include the child in resolution of conflict.

The following discipline techniques are PROHIBITED.

- \* Physical punishment.
  - \* Screaming at the child.
- \* Ridiculing a child or the child's family.
  - \* Blaming, teasing, insulting, name calling or threatening the child with punishment.
  - \* Withholding food.
  - \* Withholding of affection or positive attention.
